



Chapter Legislative Contact

Job Description

The Chapter Legislative Contact (CLC) serves as the primary ACNM chapter contact for both State and Federal legislative and regulatory information. The purpose of this key position is to serve as the link to ACNM members in order to disseminate information, and to assist in activating and educating members to advocate on behalf of midwifery at the state and federal level.

Duties:

- Disseminates state/federal legislative and regulatory information provided by ACNM to chapter members.
- Gathers and shares state/federal legislative and regulatory information from the chapter with ACNM's National Office.
- Represents ACNM members at meetings addressing state/federal public policy issues and legislation.
- Coordinates contact with chapter members to build relationships with individual state legislators and members of Congress.
- Services as a primary chapter contact for activities relating to Midwives PAC.

Term of Service:

The CLC representative agrees to serve for a period of no less than two years and to assist in the identification and orientation of their successor. It will be necessary for this individual to have access to email, as this will be the primary mode of communication with the ACNM National Office.
